

WELCOME

Welcome to Carrington Cottage, at Dennes Point on the northern tip of Tasmania's famed Bruny Island.

Family, friends and guests have enjoyed this cosy holiday cottage and its idyllic beachside setting for more than ten years. We are certain you will, too.

If you love Carrington Cottage, you may also love our other 'island shack' - Spring Beach Holiday House, near Orford on Tasmania's East Coast. In the family since the 1970s, and fully refurbished in 2016, this house has million-dollar water views and sits virtually waterfront on pristine Spring Beach.

THE COTTAGE

Carrington Cottage (centre of photo) dates from the 1950s and is a traditional Dennes Point beachside shack looking out over beautiful D'Entrecasteaux Channel and a mere 50 metres to North Bruny's clean, safe Nebraska Beach.

DENNES POINT

DINING AND ART

Enjoy superb views and fine food at the licensed *Jetty Café*, and local artists' work at the *Art at the Point* gallery, both a few minutes' walk north of the cottage.

WILDERNESS AND WILDLIFE

Bruny Island is a world recognised birdwatcher's paradise. All 12 of Tasmania's endemic bird species are found on the Island. Around the cottage, especially at dusk, look out for native mammals (Eastern quolls, wallabies, pademelons and echidnas). Schools of dolphins travel the D'Entrecasteaux Channel.

SAILING AND DIVING

The Channel is recognised as one of the world's finest waterways and cruising grounds. A launching ramp is located on Nebraska Beach, 100 metres north of the cottage, and a jetty is 350 metres away. We also offer, free of charge, our own all-weather, fully-maintained mooring directly offshore from the cottage.





COTTAGE ACCOMMODATION







LIVING/DINING

We have extensively refurbished the shack, with open plan living, a modern kitchen, a lounge with LCD TV and DVD and wood heater.

BEDROOMS/BATHROOM

Bedroom 1 – One queen bed.

Bedroom 2 – Two single beds


and a trundle bed.

There is a modern, separate
bathroom with toilet and

shower.

DECK/GARDEN

French doors open to a large wrap-around timber deck.
Outside, there's a gas BBQ, two picnic tables, a laundry with washing machine and dryer, and lawn and garden.









WHAT TO BRING

Bring all food, toiletries and beach towels. Basic food items are available from the Jetty Café (newspapers, home-grown produce; 03 6260 6245), and the small takeaway at the ferry terminal at Roberts Point.

Fuel is not available at Dennes Point. The nearest outlet is the supermarket at Adventure Bay, 43km and 50 minutes' drive south of Dennes Point

Carrington Cottage is strictly non-smoking.

We do not allow pets anywhere on the property.

WE PROVIDE

We provide free of charge basic foods (tea, coffee, sugar, pepper, salt, condiments, oil, etc), firewood for the wood heater (with a safety fire screen), gas for the BBQ, and water from rainwater tanks (capacity 16,000L; we recommend you boil all drinking water). We do not provide a cleaning service during your stay.

Linen is supplied as a linen pack and towel on each bed for you to make up. The packs contain freshlylaundered fitted sheet, flat sheet, doona cover and pillow cases. Beach towels are not provided.

RATES

Please enquire about our rates at info@islandshacks.com. The base nightly rate is for two people, for two or more nights.

Additional charges apply for each extra person per night. There is no charge for infants in cots (cot provided) and babies.

Carrington Cottage is also available for single nights, but conditions apply.

Rates are subject to change without notice.


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
CHECK-IN

Check-out time is 10am; check-in time is 2pm. These times can be varied by prior arrangement.

DIRECTIONS

You will spend a relaxing 15 minutes on the vehicular ferry, crossing D'Entrecasteaux Channel from Kettering to Roberts Point. In busy periods, two ferries operate. From Roberts Point, travel 9km on bitumen road B66 and, at the well-marked junction, turn left (north) and stay on gravel road C625 to Dennes Point (10km; about 15 minutes' drive).
